The giant panda of China is one of the best known *endangered species on the earth. There are about 1750 giant pandas living in the world today. These black and white bears are gentle *vegetarians, and their (7) favorite food is bamboo. In the wild, they live in the high mountains of China, but many giant pandas now live in zoos in carefully controlled environments. Japan has giant pandas in zoos in Tokyo, Kobe, and Shirahama. The United States has giant pandas in zoos in four cities. All the giant pandas have Chinese names. For example, a male panda named Ling Ling lives in Tokyo's Ueno Zoo. Lun Lun and Yang Yang live in Zoo Atlanta.

My Chinese wife had the (4)rare opportunity to come into contact with giant pandas thanks to her work for a Japanese *x-ray company. (A) <u>Like most Chinese people</u>, my wife loves pandas and wants to help save them from disappearing. She convinced her company to donate an (4)expensive x-ray machine to the giant panda research center in *Chengdu, China. She and her boss flew to Chengdu to help train the staff at the center in how to use the x-ray machine.

In Chengdu, they tested the *equipment on a one-year-old, 38-kilogram giant panda named Jing Jing, the (_)official animal for the 2008 Beijing Olympics. The staff at the zoo showed him an apple *dipped in honey to attract him to the x-ray area. Then eight staff members turned him on his back and took (_)quick x-rays of his chest. (B) My wife was surprised that he made noises like our eight-month-old son crying.
