5 「タイの人々が身につけるお守り(amulet)」に関する次の文を読んで、下記の質問に答えなさい。

From a very young age, (A) boys in Thailand wear amulets that they believe will protect them from sickness and accidents. As these boys grow into teenagers, amulets become increasingly (7) important to them for their protective powers. The most (4) popular amulet, which is worn on a chain around a man's neck, is the \*image of Buddha. These Buddha images come in a variety of materials and sizes. Some are made of wood, some metal, and some ivory. Colored plastic and colored glass amulets have also \*caught on in (9) recent years. The smallest ones are only two centimeters across, and the biggest ones seven to eight centimeters.

Another type of popular amulet has the image of a \*sacred person on one side and magical phrases printed on the other. Images of \*monks that are famous for their (6) magical powers are popular, as is the image of King Chulalongkorn, a \*revered king in Thai history. Prized amulets are made by monks, but many amulets, (8) particularly those that do not have the image of Buddha, are made \*commercially. One of the most interesting sights in Bangkok is the Amulet Market near the \*Grand Palace. (B) Many men spend hours there looking for the right amulet to protect them from \*misfortune.
